London Underground Paper Model

Instructions

- 1. Begin by cutting out the shape on page 1. This shape will form the train and rail tracks. Cut along the thick black lines including around tabs 2 and 3 and those at the front of the train.
- 2. Fold all dotted lines into a hill fold (folded downwards) or valley fold (folded upwards) as shown on the key.
- 3. Apply glue to tabs 2 and 3 and stick to the underside of the front of the train.
- 4. Cut out the shape on page 2. This shape will form the platform.
- 5. Cut along the thick black lines including around tabs 7, 8 and 9.
- 6. You will need to make a cut between the two number 7 tabs and along the front of the escalators. Also make sure that you cut along the long, thin section until the third fold line.
- 7. Apply glue to tab 7 and stick to the other tab 7.
- 8. Apply glue to tabs 8, 9 and 10. Place the train in front of the tunnel with the train front facing forwards. Stick tab 9 inside the train. Stick tab 8 under the platform. Stick tab 10 behind the back wall.
- 9. Apply glue to tab 1 and 6. Stick tab 6 under the platform. Stick tab 1 behind the wall.
- 10. Apply glue to tab 4 and stick below the rail tracks. Check that you have the correct folds in place.
- 11. Apply glue to tab 5 and stick to form a raised platform.
- 12. Apply glue to tab 11. Fold the associated tab around and stick in place. This forms the back wall of the station.
- 13. Apply glue to the end of the long, thin section and stick it to the station wall making sure the platform sign is sticking out.

Your London Underground model is now complete! All aboard!
